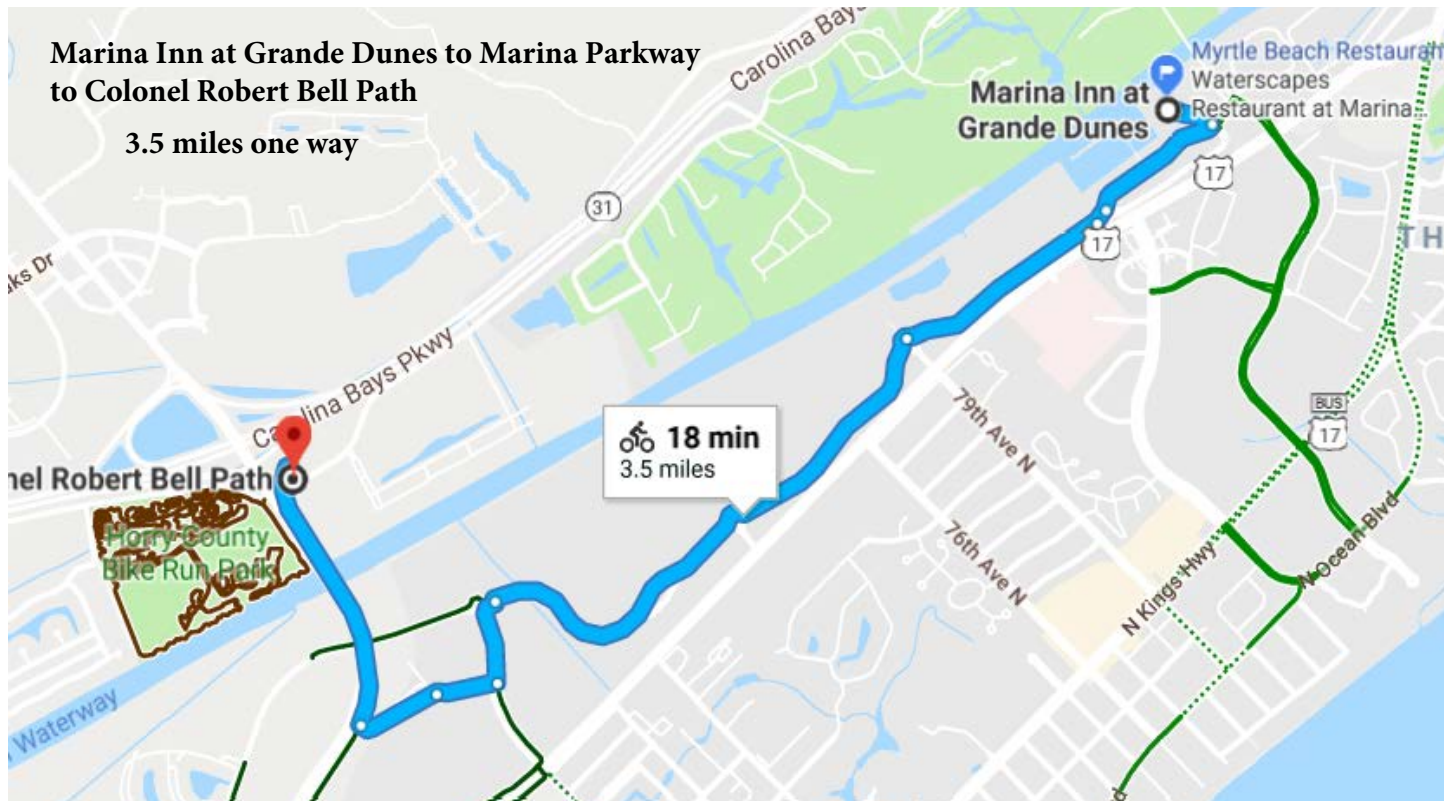


Marina Inn at Grande Dunes to Marina Parkway to Colonel Robert Bell Path

- ↑ Head southeast on Amalfi Pl
463 ft
- 📍 At the traffic circle, take the 1st exit onto Marina Pkwy
0.3 mi
- 📍 At the traffic circle, continue straight to stay on Marina Pkwy
180 ft
- ↘ Slight right
0.5 mi
- ↙ Turn left
1.3 mi

- ↙ Turn left
23 ft
- ↘ Slight right at Marina Pkwy
0.2 mi
- ↘ Turn right
0.1 mi
- ↙ Slight left at Claire Chapin Epps Dr
0.2 mi
- ↘ Turn right onto Colonel Robert Bell Path
0.6 mi
- ↘ Turn right to stay on Colonel Robert Bell Path
187 ft

This is a nice, easy bike/walk dedicated path that begins traveling along the scenic Marina Inn Parkway, passing the Grande Dunes Marina then along the mostly undeveloped, yet beautifully landscaped Marina Parkway. Look for 62nd Ave. N and turn left. Then take next right on Claire Chapin Epps Drive - going along the path by the YMCA that will connect with mostly flat Colonel Robert Bell Path where you will turn right. This path continues parallel to Robert Grissom Parkway and ends at Frontage Road B-2. The path is walkable in 1.8 hours or by bike in 18 minutes one way. This path crosses over a bridge however, the path is protected from traffic.

NOTE: At Frontage Road B-2 - this path connects to the Horry County Bike/Run Park - a challenging biking/jogging/walking trail that hosts many tri-athlon events.
